Foundation Innovation Prize	Awarded to an FY1 or FY2 doctor for a medical education project already undertaken.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 2 awards per year to a value of £200. • Invited to present at TASME Spring Conference. • Certificate. 	January
Student Innovation Prize	Awarded to a Student for a project or piece of work surrounding an original and innovative idea that has already been undertaken.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 1 award per year of £100. • Invited to present at TASME Spring Conference. • Certificate. 	January
Sir John Ellis Student Prize	Rewards excellence in a piece of work, survey, research or innovation in which submitter has been directly involved in the field of medical education.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 1 award per year of £300 per submission in 2 categories: SSM or Intercalated. • Presentation of submission at ASM. • Registration fee for one person per winning submission at ASM. • Certificate. 	February
