Who are TASME?

Many trainees enjoy teaching, but getting involved and staying involved in medical education as a busy junior can be difficult. **TASME (Trainees in the Association for the Study of Medical Education)** is a Career Group of ASME that aims to support trainee involvement in teaching. It is run by a committee of trainees from a number of specialties, with the support of the ASME Board of Directors.

TASME was formed to provide a platform for trainees to share ideas and experiences within medical education.

TASME is designed to benefit trainees with an interest in medical education (be it teaching or research) through the following aims:

- To foster an interest in medical education amongst juniors through activities, events and discussion that support trainee involvement in medical education
- To influence medical education policy and practice through representation within ASME
- To encourage and promote good practice by developing systematic training in medical education and research
- To create a forum for trainees to exchange viewpoints and experiences of medical education and discuss their role within it
- To encourage, promote and conduct medical education research initiated by trainees
- To promote on-going involvement in teaching throughout training and careers in medical education

TASME Events

- TASME run a host of events throughout the year, from regional events to workshops at the ASME Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM).
- Our main event of the year is the TASME Spring Conference. This is a 1 day medical education conference featuring lectures from prominent keynote speakers and interactive workshops. There is also the chance to submit your work as an oral presentation or to be part of the conference poster fair and have the opportunity to win a prize.

Awards - *Just for TASME members*

Teaching Innovation and Excellence Prize

An annual prize recognizing talent and ingenuity displayed by those embarking on a career in medical education. The prize will be primarily focused on recognizing teaching but consideration will be given to entries that showcase other relevant educational activity.

Poster Prize

The TASME poster prize is an annual prize, designed to recognize creativity and achievement displayed by those embarking on a career in medical education. The poster can encompass any aspect of medical education including educational research, teaching activity and innovation.

Bursary for Professional Development

This is a bursary whereby successful applicants can be awarded funding towards a specific medical education event or project. Applicants will be chosen on the basis of their commitment to medical education and the proposal for the use of the bursary.



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
